## Expression of Interest – Artist & Creative Worker Application

2018 will see the return of the Generate event taking place in Caboolture Town Square on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June. Proudly presented by Moreton Bay Region Industry & Tourism (MBRIT) and Moreton Bay Regional Council (MBRC), **Generate** will aim to activate the Town Square precinct through the use of creative works, including visual art installations, projections, workshops, stage entertainment, art and craft markets and more.

**Generate** will aim to showcase the talents of local artists, groups and schools as part of the key engagement strategy. We are currently looking for Expressions of Interest from individuals and groups that may be interested in participating in this exciting new event.

### Details:

**Event Dates:** Friday 29<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018

**Venue:** Caboolture Hub & Town Square, King St, Caboolture

### **There are six key avenues in which artists and creative workers/groups can be involved in the festival:**

- **1. The Generate 'Gallery'** – The Gallery will be an immersive and exciting display of local contemporary art. This opportunity is open to various creative works, including, but not limited to: paintings, photography, woodwork, metal work, glass painting, mosaics, pottery, sculptures, wearable art and other formats of art. Multiple submissions are accepted and encouraged. A small cost will apply to cover the cost of providing infrastructure to hang your works (Approx. \$50 depending on the number of exhibitors). You are welcome to sell your pieces in the gallery at your own discretion.
- **2. Generate Cube Murals** – There will be the opportunity for individuals / groups to paint a mural/s on the sides of large ply cubes (provided) which will be erected in town square as part of a temporary public art project. Murals will be painted 'live' onsite during the running of the event and there may be opportunities for audience participation.
- **3. Generate Large-Scale Sculptural Pieces** – Town Square will come alive with large temporary sculptural pieces, which will form part of the Generate Arts Trail, a contemporary installation featuring large pieces made from various materials, including found and repurposed items. These installations will ideally be assessed individually with minimum size dimensions 1.5m x 1.5m + and will need to be structurally sound.
- **4. Main Stage Content Contribution** – This opportunity is open to any performer, artist, musician, busker, dance or performance-based act that may be interested. It also includes artistic works such as short films or animation, and wearable art.
- **5. Workshops** – This opportunity is open to groups or individuals who wish to run creative workshops during the event. Ideally, workshops would run for multiple sessions during the day at a running time of 30 – 45 minutes per session. Workshops can be open to all participants, or targeted to specific groups, such as children.

There will be remuneration offered for participation in most categories and all opportunities are open to both individuals and groups. We are calling for Expressions of Interest from those that would like to receive more information.
